RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE LEASE OF LAND AT GROVES PLANTATION, ST. GEORGE IN BARBADOS AGRICULTURAL MANAGEMENT COMPANY LIMITED

Senator the Hon. Miss M. P. O. McClean spoke on the following:

RESOLVED that Parliament in accordance with section 5 of the *Crown Lands* (*Vesting and Disposal*) *Act*, Cap. 225 approve the lease to the Barbados Agricultural Management Company Limited of the parcel of land, together with the buildings thereon, the property of the Crown situate at Groves Plantation, Groves in the parish of Saint George in this Island, more particularly described in the *First Schedule* hereto on the terms and conditions set out in the *Second Schedule* hereto to provide accommodation for the Agronomy Research and Variety Testing Unit.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND situate at Groves in the parish of Saint George in this Island being Lot G containing by admeasurement 6,617 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or formerly of the Groves Agricultural Station on Lot A, also being lands now or formerly of the Groves Agricultural Station, on other lands now or formerly of the Groves Agricultural Station and on a road leading to a public road which leads to Highway 3B in one direction and to Market Hill in the other direction or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a Plan certified on the 26th day of June, 1996 by Andrew P. Weekes, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 2nd day of August, 1996 as Plan No. 636/96.

APPROVED by the House of Assembly the 16th day of December, 2014.

SECOND SCHEDULE

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The lease shall be for a period of fifteen (15) years with an option to renew for a further term.
- 2. The initial rent shall be at a rate at \$1 000.00 per annum, and shall be subject to review at the end of every five (5) year period within the term.
- 3. The lessee shall be responsible for the payment of insurance premiums, repairs and maintenance of the buildings, the payment of land taxes, utilities and other outgoings arising out of the use of the property.
- 4. The lessee shall bear the cost of the development of the site and shall comply with the Town and Country Planning requirements and other statutory requirements.
