An Act to validate certain acts performed by the Anti-Money Laundering Authority in pursuance of its functions under the *Money Laundering and Financing of Terrorism (Prevention and Control) Act*.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Money Laundering and Financing of Terrorism (Prevention and Control) (Validation of Functions) Act, 2009*. Short title.

Validation.
Cap. 129. **2.** All functions purported to have been performed by the Anti-Money Laundering Authority in pursuance of the *Money Laundering and Financing of Terrorism (Prevention and Control) Act* during the period 1st August, 2006 to 14th September, 2008 both dates inclusive, and all matters purported to have been done under that Act shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly performed and done as if the Authority had been lawfully and validly appointed under section 5 of that Act.
