A Bill entitled

An Act to validate the functions performed and the decisions given by the person functioning as the National Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the *National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) Regulations, 1967* from 1st January, 2004 to 26th September, 2010.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *National Insurance Commissioner (Validation) Act, 2010*. Short title.

Validation. 2. All functions performed and decisions given by the person functioning as the National Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the *National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) Regulations, 1967* and all matters done in relation thereto during the period 1st January, 2004 to 26th September, 2010, both dates inclusive, shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly performed, given and done as if that functionary had been lawfully and validly appointed in accordance with regulation 14 of the *National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Question) Regulations, 1967*.
