BARBADOS

A Bill entitled

An Act to amend the Severance Payments Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Severance Payments (Amendment) short title. Act, 2006.

Amendment of section 2 of the Severance Payments Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by inserting the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order:

" "pensionable age" means each age corresponding with the period prescribed as set out in Part II of the *First Schedule*;".

Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the words
"Part I of" immediately before the words "the First Schedule" appearing
therein.

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "the age of 65 years" appearing therein and substituting the words "pensionable age".

Amendment of section 26A of Cap. 355A.

- (a) in subsection (1), by deleting the words "Sections 43, 43A and 43B" and substituting the words "Sections 43, 43A, 43B, 43C and 43D";
- (b) in subsection (2), by deleting the words "sections 43, 43A and 43B" and substituting the words "sections 43, 43A, 43B, 43C and 43D"; and
- (c) by inserting immediately after subsection (2) the following:

"(2A) Notwithstanding subsection (2), section 43C of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act* shall apply to sections 3 and 25 of this Act, with such modifications as are necessary."

6. The First Schedule of the principal Act is amended by

(a) renumbering that Schedule as Part I thereof; and
