Will the Minister please state how many of those temporary and acting officers are entitled to be appointed pursuant to the said Public Service Act? 3. Will the Minister please give a timeframe within which those said temporary or acting officers entitled to be appointed will be appointed?

- *4. Mr. Rawle Eastmond (St. James North): To ask the Minister of Transport, Works and International Transport:** 1.
