FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Harrisons in the parish of Saint Lucy in this Island, containing by admeasurement 131080.6 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 2289 square metres in road) and abutting and bounding on lands now or late of Fairfield Investments Limited (Harrison's Plantation), on other lands now or late of the Barbados Government, on other lands now or late of Fairfield Investments Limited and on a public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 14th day of December, 2007 by Garrick L. Jenkins, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 18th day of December, 2007 as Plan No. 1746/2007.

SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land (part of a larger parcel of land containing by admeasurement 50 acres 12 perches) situate at Harrisons in the parish of Saint Lucy in this Island, containing by admeasurement 20.40 hectares or thereabouts and abutting and bounding on other lands now or late of the Barbados Government, on lands now or late of Roy Ward, on lands now or late of Delphi Tropical Holdings Limited, on the sea, on lands now or late of Fairfield Investments Limited, on other lands now or late of the Barbados Government (Harrison Point Lighthouse) and on a road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 12th day of August, 1994 by G. D. Walcott, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 1st day of November, 1994 as Plan No. 1022/94.

ADDENDUM

On the 17th day of April, 2008, the Cabinet agreed to the vesting of the parcels of land described in the Schedules hereto in Barbados Tourism Investment Inc.

The parcel of land described in the *First Schedule*, acquired by the Crown pursuant to section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228 and Statutory Instrument No. 29 of 1986 dated 6th March, 1986 for use in agricultural training in the National Youth Service Scheme and recreational purposes, is no longer required for the purposes for which it was acquired.

The parcel of land described in the *Second Schedule* was vested in the Crown by section 24(a) of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225.

In accordance with section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in Barbados Tourism Investment Inc. of the parcels of land described in the Schedules.
