SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land the property of Sterlin Russell situate at Huntles Road, Carrington Village, in the parish of Saint Michael, in this Island containing by admeasurement 178.3 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of Una Chase on lands now or late of Sonia Gooding on lands now or late of Herman Gill on lands now or late of Ena Holder on lands now or late of Joseph St. Hill and on a public road called Huntles Road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 25th day of November, 2008 by Michael L. Banfield, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 25th day of November, 2008 as Plan No. 1457/2008.

ADDENDUM

On the 22nd day of November, 2007, the Cabinet agreed to the acquisition of the parcel of land situate at Huntles Road, Carringtons Village, in the parish of Saint Michael and described in the *Schedule* for the public purpose of facilitating a housing development to be executed under the Urban Development Commission's House Repair/Replacement Programme.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the parcel of land described in the *Schedule* in order that the purpose set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land.
