SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land the property of the Anderson Nicholls situate at Sturges in the parish of Saint Thomas, in this Island, containing by admeasurement 8,748.2 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding to the north on lands now or late of the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation to the east lands now or late of on lands now or late of Barbados Broadcasting Service Ltd. on lands now or late of Communication Advantage Inc. and on other lands now or late of the said Anderson Nicholls and to the south on other lands now or late of the said Anderson Nicholls and to the west on lands now or late of the Barbados National Trust and on other lands now or late of the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 31st day of March, 2004 by Roger N. Parravincino, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 20th day of May, 2004 as Plan No, 553/2004.

ADDENDUM

The Cabinet at its meeting of the 16th of August, 2001, agreed to the acquisition of Lot 5, Sturges Plantation in the parish of Saint Thomas more particularly described in the Schedule hereto for the enhancement of the security at the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation. This parcel of land lies directly in the path of the microwave links of the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation from its studios in the parish of Saint Michael, and one of the guys which supports the 500 feet mast of the said Corporation, passes over a small portion of the property.

The approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto in order that the purpose set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land.
