PARLIAMENT

RESOLVED that Parliament approve in accordance with section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act, Cap. 225* the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the parcels of land situate at Hopeland near Rices in the parish of Saint Philip in this Island and more particularly described in the Schedules hereto for the purpose of housing development.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Hopeland, near Rices in the parish of Saint Philip in this Island containing by admeasurement 3.621 hectares or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on a right of way 3.61 metres wide on lands now or late of Winifred Bunjan on lands now or late of Carol Fields on lands now or late of Israel Gay on lands now or late of Eldean Clarke on lands now or late of Astratha Rice on lands now or late of Carlston Brathwaite on lands now or late of the National Housing Corporation on lands now or late of Carol Fields and on the public road called Highway N or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified the 31st day of August, 2000 by Andrew R. Bourne, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 1st day of September, 2000 as Plan No. 785/2000.

SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Hopeland, near Rices in the parish of Saint Philip in this Island containing by admeasurement 1.342 hectares or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of Israel Gay on lands now or late of Carol Fields on lands now or late of Winifred Bunjan on lands now or late of Mary Brathwaite on lands now or late of Inez Walcott on lands now or late of Benjamin Greenidge on lands now or late of George Gill on lands now or late of Wendy Drakes on lands now or late of the Joseph Walcott and on a road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified the 31st day of August, 2000 by Andrew R. Bourne, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 1st day of September, 2000 as Plan No. 785/2000.

ADDENDUM

On the 7th October, 1999 the Cabinet agreed that the parcel of land situate at Hopeland near Rices in Saint Philip and containing 4.963 hectares (being one area containing 3.621 hectares and the other area containing 1.342 hectares) should be acquired for the purpose of housing development and that thereafter the said parcel should be vested in the National Housing Corporation.

The said parcel of land became vested in the Crown by virtue of a Conveyance dated the 19th day of March 2001, Carol Fields to the Crown and recorded in the Land Registry on the 16th May, 2001.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act, Cap. 225* of the Laws of Barbados, the approval of Parliament is now sought for vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the said parcels of land described in the *Schedules* to this Resolution for housing development.
