SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Mount Poyer in the parish of Saint Lucy containing by admeasurement 5 597 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of the Crown on two sides and on a public road leading to Swithins Church in one direction and to Springhall in another direction or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 27th day of June, 2005 by Lennox J. Reid, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 28th day of June, 2005 as Plan No. 735 of 2005.

ADDENDUM

On the 11th day of February 1993, the Cabinet approved the vesting of 5 964 square metres of land situate at Mount Poyer in the parish of Saint Lucy in the National Housing Corporation for the purpose of housing development. The said parcel of land was acquired on or about the 1st day of December, 1993.

On the 27th day of July, 2006, the Cabinet recognizing the increased demand for low income housing in the north of the Island, agreed to vest in the National Housing Corporation an additional 5 597 square metres of land situate at Mount Poyer in the parish of Saint Lucy more particularly described in the *Schedule* to this Resolution.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act, Cap. 225 the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution for the purpose of housing development.
