SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Barbarees Hill in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island (formerly said to contain 8436.43 square metres) but found by recent survey to contain by admeasurement 8403.0 square metres (inclusive of 39.4 square metres in verge) Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of the Trustees of the Barbarees Hill Church of Christ on lands now or late of Western Trading Co. Ltd. on lands of sundry owners on lands now or late of Saint Leonard's Church on lands now or late of the Estate of Reginald Patrick Medford "Medford's Mahogany Creations" and on a public road called Barbarees Hill or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 31st day of July 2001 by F. H. Godson, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 7th day of August 2001 as Plan No. 794/2001.

ADDENDUM

On the 2nd day of September, 2004, the Cabinet agreed that the parcel of land situate at Barbarees Hill in the parish of Saint Michael together with the building thereon and containing 8403.0 square metres should be acquired for the purpose of housing development and that thereafter the said land should be vested in the National Housing Corporation.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the said parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution for housing development.
