## **SCHEDULE**

**ALL THAT** certain piece or parcel of land situate at Fairy Valley in the parish of Christ Church in this Island containing by admeasurement 21605.9 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding now or formerly on other lands of Fairy Valley Plantation, on lands now or late of William J. Gooding, on lands now or late of the Estate of Sarah Rice, on lands now or late of Leotta Clarke on lands now or late of Lornita Yarde on lands now or late of Vincent Trotman on lands now or late of Herbert Best on lands now or late of Maise M. Best on lands now or late of Carmen Rice on lands now or late of Karen L. Yarde on lands now or late of Evangeline Best on lands now or formerly of the Barbados Government on lands now or late of Elfreda Prescod and on a public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1999 by Andrew R. Bannister, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June, 1999 as Plan No. 492/99.

## ADDENDUM

The Cabinet at its meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 1998 agreed *inter alia* to the acquisition of 53 parcels of land at Thyme Bottom and Fairy Valley in the parish of Christ Church for the purposes of the expansion of the Grantley Adams International Airport and also agreed to the relocation of those persons who would be displaced as a result of such expansion.

The Cabinet further agreed that the relocated householders should be given the option to purchase the lot on which they are relocated.

The Cabinet at its meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2005 agreed that the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution, which was part of the Fairy Valley Plantation that was acquired by the Crown in 1965 from Oldbury Estates Ltd., should be vested in the National Housing Corporation for the purposes of housing development. The vesting of the land in the National Housing Corporation will facilitate the transfer of the lots to the displaced householders.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act, Cap. 225*, the approval of Parliament is sought for the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the said parcel of land.
