**MINISTERS AND PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES
(CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) ORDER, 2022**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5 of the *Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries (Conditions of Service) Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries (Conditions of Service) Order, 2022*.
2. The Schedule to the *Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries (Conditions of Service) Act* is deleted and the Schedule set out in the *Schedule* to this Order is substituted.
3. The emoluments specified in the *Schedule* shall be payable from the date specified therein.
