The *Public Service (Part-time Officers) Order, 2018* has been laid in Parliament.

2. The Order provides for an increase in the salaries of part-time officers of 5% with effect from 1st April, 2018.

PUBLIC SERVICE (PART-TIME OFFICERS) ORDER, 2018

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 13(1) of the *Public Service Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Public Service (Part-Time Officers) Order, 2018*.
2. The offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* are established offices.
3. There are attached to the offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* the emoluments set out in the second column of the *Schedule*.
4. The emoluments set out in the second column of the *Schedule* shall be payable on 1st April, 2018.
- 5.(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), the Governor-General may appoint to the offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* such part-time officers as he considers necessary.
(2) The number of part-time officers appointed under sub-paragraph (1) may not at any time exceed the number specified in the third column of the *Schedule*.
6. Where the emoluments of an established office referred to in this Order are on a scale divided into segments by the symbol “.”, an officer holding

any such office is not entitled to the emoluments of the scale beyond the point at which the symbol appears except on such conditions as the Governor-General determines in relation to offices of that class.

7. The *Public Service (Part-Time Officers) Order, 2008* (S.I. 2008 No. 115) is revoked.
