An Act to amend the Charities Act, Cap. 243.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Charities (Amendment) Act, 2019.*

Amendment of section 2 of Cap. 243

- 2. Section 2 of the Charities Act, Cap. 243 in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by inserting the following definition in the appropriate alphabetical order:
 - " "prominent public office" means any of the following offices in Barbados and includes a corresponding office in a foreign state:
 - (a) the head of state;
 - (b) any judicial office;
 - (c) a Permanent Secretary, deputy Permanent Secretary, a Head of Department or deputy Head of Department;
 - (d) a Minister, a member of the House of Assembly or a Senator;
 - (e) a chief executive officer, deputy chief executive officer or a member of the Board of a statutory board, a statutory corporation or a state owned enterprise;
 - (f) a senior military officer;
 - (g) a member of the executive of a political party;
 - (h) a chief executive officer, deputy chief executive officer, director, deputy director or a member of the Board of an international organization;
 - (i) any other office, by whatever name called, similar to the offices mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (h);".

Amendment of section 5 of Cap. 243

3. Section 5 of the principal Act, is amended by inserting immediately after subsection (7) the following:

"(7A) Every application for a charity to be registered shall be in the Form 1 prescribed in the *Second Schedule*.".

Amendment of section 9 of Cap. 243

- 4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by deleting subsection (3) and substituting the following:
 - "(3) Every application respecting trustees of a charity to be incorporated as a Board shall be in the Form 2 prescribed in the *Second Schedule* and shall be signed by the majority of the trustees.".

Repeal and replacement of Second Schedule of Cap. 243

5. The Second Schedule to the principal Act is deleted and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Act substituted.
