OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill would

- (a) provide for the *Final Appropriation Act* for the Financial Year 2014-2015; and
- (*b*) validate anything done in connection with the grant and issue of \$188,131,002 out of the Consolidated Fund and the application of the same for the services of this Island for the Financial Year aforesaid.

BARBADOS

A Bill entitled

An Act to validate the grant of an additional sum of money out of the Consolidated Fund and for the appropriation of the same for the services of the Island for the Financial Year that ended 31st March, 2015.

WHEREAS the sum of money granted out of the Consolidated Fund by the *Appropriation Act, 2014* for the services of the Island for the Financial Year ended 31st March, 2015 has proved insufficient to meet the demands for such services;

AND WHEREAS certain Resolutions were passed during the Financial Year that ended 31st March, 2015 granting additional sums out of the Consolidated Fund for the services of that year, and it is deemed expedient to appropriate the same in the manner hereinafter mentioned;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Final Appropriation (2014-2015) Act, 2017.*

Supplementary grant of \$188,131,002

2. The Accountant General may, on the warrant of the Minister or some person authorised by the Minister in writing, issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply for making good the sums granted for the supply of services for the year ended 31st March, 2015, the sum of one hundred and eighty-eight million, one hundred and thirty one thousand and two dollars.

Date on which grant took effect

3. The sum granted by this Act shall be deemed to have been granted on the 1st April, 2014 in addition to the sum granted by the *Appropriation Act*, 2014.

Appropriation of sum granted

4. The sum granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Fund for making good the sums granted for the purpose specified in section 2 is appropriated from 1st April, 2014 for the purposes specified in the *Schedule*.

Validation

5. Anything which has been done in the purported exercise of any such power as is mentioned in section 2, shall be deemed to have been as lawfully done as if the *Final Appropriation (2014-2015) Act, 2015* had been enacted.
