Independent Auditors' Report

To the Shareholders of Amphora Bank & Trust Corporation Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

We have audited the financial statements of Amphora Bank & Trust Corporation (the "Company"), which comprise the statement of financial position as at April 30, 2019, the statements of changes in equity, profit or loss and other comprehensive income and cash flows for the year then ended, and notes, comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Company as at April 30, 2019, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (ISAs).
