CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Board of Directors is pleased to report on the financial year ended 31 December 2025, during which the Company demonstrated another year of continued growth and solid fundamentals in a competitive insurance market.

The Company reported net income after taxes of \$3.23 million, reflecting profitability and prudent financial management. Net comprehensive income was \$2.93 million after adjusting for an unrealized loss. Insurance service revenue grew to \$85.62 million, an increase of \$6.68 million or 8.5% over the prior year, with balanced growth across all lines of business. During the fiscal year, the Company settled claims totalling \$48 million, reflecting our continued commitment to honouring policyholder obligations in a timely and equitable manner.

The Company's balance sheet remains robust. Total assets increased to \$104.24 million from \$92.81 million (a 12.3% growth), and shareholders' equity strengthened to \$21.09 million from \$18.17 million (a 16.1% increase). This growth reflects our commitment to building long-term shareholder value while maintaining the financial strength necessary to honour policyholder commitments.

Looking ahead, we remain committed to providing exceptional service, maintaining financial strength, and creating value for all stakeholders. We extend our sincere gratitude to our policyholders, staff, and business partners for their continued support.
