CHAIRMAN'S REVIEW

Sagicor Life Inc is a wholly owned subsidiary of Sagicor Financial Company Ltd., the parent company of the Sagicor Group. Sagicor Life Inc operates in the Caribbean and is also the intermediate parent company for Sagicor's Caribbean operations. Its principal activities are the provision of insurance (life, annuity, health, and property and casualty) and financial services, including pension management, asset management and banking.

The Sagicor Life Inc Group closed 2025 with a strong performance delivering net income attributable to the shareholder of BBD \$203.7 million, compared to BBD \$112.9 million in the prior year. Net insurance and investment result stood at BBD \$781.3 million, compared to the prior year's amount of BBD \$586.3 million. The financial position of the Sagicor Life Inc Group remains strong, with assets totalling BBD \$14.2 billion and liabilities of BBD \$11.5 billion, resulting in Group equity of BBD \$2.7 billion, compared to prior year's level

of BBD \$2.5 billion. Shareholder's equity was BBD \$1.9 billion, compared to BBD \$1.8 billion in the prior year.

Note 1 - BASIS OF PREPARATION
