**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Rally Barbados Event") Directions, 2026*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified periods:

On Saturday May 30, 2026

- (a) Between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Philip, the section of road known as Harrow Road, proceeding in a north-easterly direction on Harrow Road, continuing in a south-easterly direction to the Bushy Park Triangle, continuing easterly then northerly on the Fairfield Sandford Mapps Road, continuing in an easterly direction along Highway L (Mapps Road) and finishing at the junction of Thickets/Supers Road.
- (b) Between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint Joseph, the section of road known as Highway Y (Mount Tabor), proceeding in a southerly direction along Highway Y (Mount Tabor), continuing in a westerly direction along Highway 3C, proceeding in a north-westerly direction on Wilson Hill Village Road onto Easy Hall Road, continuing along Highway 3E (Cotton Tower Road), proceeding south-westerly along Highway 3D (McCollit Bridge) and finishing at the junction of Highway 3 (Blackmans).

- (c) Between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint George, the section of the road known as Featherbed Lane/Kendal Road, proceeding in a north-easterly direction on Kendal Road, continuing in a northerly direction on Cliff Road to the junction with Highway 4 (Guinea Road), continuing westerly on Highway 4 (Guinea Road), proceeding in a south-westerly direction on Kendal/Woodland Road, proceeding in a northerly direction on the Highway Y (Todds/Woodland Road), continuing in a westerly direction on the Todds/Ellesmere Road and finishing at the junction of Logan and St. Judes Road.

On Sunday May 31, 2026

- (a) Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Philip, the section of the road known as Highway L (Three Houses), proceeding in a south-easterly direction along Highway L (Mapps Road), continuing in a westerly direction along Sandford Fairfield Road and finishing at the junction of Highway M (Bushy Park).
- (b) Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John the section of road known as Highway J (Society), proceeding in a westerly direction on Society Road, continuing north-westerly along Highway H (Society), proceeding south-westerly along Highway 4A (Ashford), continuing westerly along Cherry Grove Road to finish on Cherry Grove Road.
- (c) Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint Joseph, the section of road known as Gutter Road, commencing from its junction with Highway 3 (Andrews), proceeding in an easterly direction along the said Gutter Road, continuing in a north-easterly direction on Sweet Vale/Claybury Road, continuing in a northerly direction on Wilson Hill Road onto Easy Hall Road, continuing in an easterly direction on Highway 3E (Malvern) to finish on Malvern/Edge Cliff Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Barbados Police Service in uniform commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Barbados Police Service, the Barbados Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.

**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "BRC Summer Stages Speed Event") Directions, 2026*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified periods:

On Sunday August 23, 2026

(a) Between the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint George, the section of the road known as Highway 4 (Kendal/Woodland), proceeding in a south-westerly direction on Kendal/Woodland Road, continuing in a northerly direction on the Highway Y (Todds/Woodland Road), continuing in a westerly direction on the Todds/Ellesmere Road and finishing at the junction of Logan and St. Judes Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Barbados Police Service in uniform commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Barbados Police Service, the Barbados Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
