The Honourable the Senate has the honour to inform the Honourable the House of Assembly that at its sitting on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 the Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2018 and the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill, 2018 were amended in the terms as cited below.

In the Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2018 at Clause 2 the definition of "CARICOM" was deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"Community" or "CARICOM" means the Caribbean Community established by Article 2 of the Treaty and includes the CARICOM Single Market and Economy signed at Nassau, the Bahamas on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2001.;

and placed after the definition "code share information".

And the definition of "Treaty" was deleted.

In the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill, 2018 at Clause 2 the paragraph (i) was deleted

AND the Honourable the Senate transmits the Amended Bills to the Honourable the House of Assembly inviting concurrence in the amendments to the Bills.
