### **REPORT ON THE BARBADOS GENERAL ELECTION 2018**

### 1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 On Friday April 27, 2018, Writs for an election in the thirty (30) constituencies were issued by the Governor-General, to the thirty (30) Returning Officers listed in Appendix A, who were appointed under Section 31 of the Representation of The People Act, Cap 12 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").
- 1.2 The Writs, issued in accordance with Section 36(1) of the Act, appointed:-

Monday May 7, 2018 as Nomination Day,

Thursday May 24, 2018 as Polling Day and

Friday May 25, 2018 as the latest day for return of the Writs.

- 1.3 In accordance with Section 18 (1) (a) of the Act, on Friday April 27, 2018, the Governor-General issued a Proclamation declaring the period ending nineteen days after the issuing of the writs, which was Wednesday May 16, 2018, as the Special Electoral Registration Period and on Friday April 27, 2018, by Order, appointed Thursday May 17, 2018 as:
  - 1. The Polling Day for Foreign Service Electors at Missions, in accordance with Rule 44 (1); and
  - 2. The Special Polling Day for Election Officers, in accordance with Rule 30 (2A).
- In accordance with Regulation 35(1) of the Representation of the People (Registration of Electors) Regulations, 1990, the Chairman of the Electoral and Boundaries Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) by Order dated Monday April 30, 2018, directed the Chief Registering Officer to establish an Electoral Revising Centre for each constituency on Wednesday May 2, 2018. The Revising Centres remained open for the receipt of Claims until Monday May 7, 2018 with the exception of Sunday May 6, 2018 and until Wednesday May 9, 2018 for Objections.

### 2. REVISED REGISTER OF ELECTORS – PRELIMINARY LIST

- 2.1 The Commission published the Preliminary List of Electors on Monday April 30, 2018, in accordance with the provisions of Section 18 (1) (b) of the Act.
- 2.2 The Preliminary List, which comprised two hundred and fifty seven thousand, nine hundred and ninety five (257,995) electors, was made available to the political parties, independent candidates and to the general public at the Public Library, the Electoral Department and the Revising Centres. From Wednesday May 2, to Monday May 7, 2018, a notice was placed in the press, which invited the public to inspect the Preliminary List to ensure that they were registered, the notice encouraged persons whose names did not appear on the List to register on or before May 7, 2018 the day by which Claims/Applications were to be filed with the Registering Officers at the Revising Centres.
- 2.3 The public was also informed via public notices in the media that they should be registered on or before Monday May 7, 2018, in order to be eligible to vote at the election.

### 3. <u>ELECTION ADMINISTRATION</u>

3.1 The General Election of Thursday May 24, 2018 was conducted by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of the Representation of the People Act and Section 42 (1) of the Constitution of Barbados which provides that "The election of members to the House of Assembly shall be conducted under the direction and supervision of the Commission". - 3.2 In accordance with Section 30 (1) of the Act, Mrs. Angela Taylor was appointed the Supervisor of Elections and the Governor-General, in accordance with Section 30 (2) of the Act, appointed Mr. Ian Browne, the Deputy Supervisor of Elections.
- 3.3 In addition, two thousand, three hundred and twenty one (2,321) officers were engaged in the conduct of the elections, in the following categories:-

### 4. **THE CANDIDATES**

4.1 One hundred and thirty four (134) persons were duly nominated on the Monday May 7, 2018 to contest the thirty (30) seats in the election. There are as listed below:

### 5. NOMINATION CENTRES, POLLING STATIONS AND COUNTING CENTRES

- 5.1 Thirty Nomination Centres were established; one in each constituency, twenty eight were housed in government owned schools and two in privately owned buildings.
- 5.2 On Special Polling Day, ten of the thirty buildings used as polling stations were privately owned.
- 5.3 On Polling Day, the three hundred and thirteen (313) Polling Districts were divided into five hundred and forty two (542) Polling Divisions which were accommodated in two hundred and sixty three (263) buildings. Of these, one hundred and twenty two (122) were government buildings and one hundred and forty one (141) were privately owned properties.
- 5.4 Of the thirty buildings used for the counting of votes, twenty seven were government owned. A complete list of Polling Stations may be viewed at Appendix C.

### 6. **POLITICAL BROADCASTS**

- Regulations 4 (a) & (b) of the General Elections (Allocation of Broadcasting Time)
  Regulations 1990 make provision for the allocation of broadcasting time, during an election, to any political party which satisfies the Commission that no less than ten of its members are validly nominated candidates for the election.
- 6.2 The Barbados Labour Party, the Democratic Labour Party, Solution Barbados and the United Progressive Party having complied with Regulation 4 and having submitted applications for the allocation of broadcasting time, were allocated broadcasting time as follows:-

### 7. **PUBLIC RELATIONS**

- 7.1 As part of the ongoing registration outreach programme for updating the Register of Electors, with effect from August 6, 2017, the Commission, through a Public Notice, used the print and electronic media to provide the public with the criteria for being registered as an elector and invited:
  - (i) all qualified persons 18 years and over who had not yet applied to be registered as electors or who had not been photographed for a Barbados Identification Card to make the appropriate application;
  - (ii) all registered electors who had a change of address but had not yet notified the Electoral Department to complete the required Change of Residence Form (Form 10) and file it with the Department.
- 7.2 The Electoral Department's website at <a href="www.electoral.barbados.gov.bb">www.electoral.barbados.gov.bb</a> was updated to include a chatbot which provided registration and electoral information to electors. A tele-assistant was also implemented, by which electors were able to dial a telephone number and enter their National Registration Number (ID number) on the keypad, to receive information on the status of their registration and the polling station at which they were registered to vote.
- 7.3 There was an extensive use of the media over the period March 26 to May 24 by which the public was informed or reminded:
  - 1. of the several ways to check the status of their registration, the chatbot, the teleassistant, the telephone number of the Office
  - 2. of the forms of identification which may be presented at the polling station
  - 3. that Identification Cards which have been issued in excess of ten years may be presented at the polling station
  - 4. that electors without any form of identification should attend the polling station as they would be permitted to vote
  - 5. that electronic devices, smart phones, smart watches, smart pens etc., were prohibited in the polling station
  - 6. of the assistance which the Presiding Officers provides to the blind, physically incapacitated, illiterate and mentally challenged electors

- 7. that on polling day, the Electoral Office would function as an Information Centre, assisting registered electors with information on the Polling Station at which they were registered to vote
- 8. of the voting procedure; the marking of the X next to the candidate of choice, folding the ballot to hide the X and showing the Presiding Officer the special stamp before placing the ballot in the ballot box
- 9. of election day offences such as, the sale or exposure of intoxicating liquor, the use of music and paraphernalia, congregating within 100 yards of the polling station and employers to allow employees time to vote.
- 7.4 Circulars were also sent to all electors informing of Polling District and Polling Station at which they were registered to vote; the circulars were posted over the period May 11 to May 18 which gave electors adequate time to use any of the available means of checking their registration status.

### 8. LEGAL CASES

8.1 Cases were brought against the Chief Electoral Officer, the Attorney General of Barbados and the Electoral and Boundaries Commission in which commonwealth citizens whose names were not on the Register of Electors, primarily holders of the Caricom Skilled Nationals certificate, contested their eligibility to be registered as electors under Section 7 of the Representation of the People Act Chapter 12. ### 9. **REGISTER FOR ELECTIONS**

9.1 In accordance with Section 18 (3) of the Act, the Commission published a Register for Elections on Wednesday May 23, 2018, which comprised two hundred and fifty five thousand, eight hundred and eighty one (255,881) electors. It was made available to the political parties and other nominated candidates over the period Sunday May 20 to Wednesday May 23, 2018. It was also displayed for public inspection at the Public Library and the Electoral Department.

### 10. **<u>VOTING</u>**

### 10.1 VOTING BY ELECTION OFFICERS

- 10.1.1 Thursday May 17, 2018 was designated Polling Day for the Election Officers and for the first time Police Officers were included. This was done to make it convenient for Election Workers and Police Officers to exercise their franchise before the Thursday May 24, 2018, Polling Day when they would be deployed at various Polling Stations in the conduct of the poll.
- 10.1.2 Special Presiding Officers were appointed by the Commission to supervise the voting, and polling was conducted between 7.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m., at the station in each constituency designated for that purpose.
- 10.1.3 Three thousand and four (3,004) Election Workers and Police Officers were registered to vote on Special Polling Day.

### 10.2 **VOTING BY FOREIGN SERVICE ELECTORS**

- 10.2.1 Thursday May 17, 2018 was also designated as Polling Day for the Foreign Service Electors. The Electoral and Boundaries Commission in accordance with the provisions of Section 13 (1) of the Act, appointed the Heads of the Missions as Presiding Officers at the respective Missions.
- 10.2.2 Sixteen (16) Foreign Service Electors were registered to vote on Polling Day.

### 10.3 **VOTING BY OTHER ELECTORS**

- 10.3.1 Thursday May 24, 2018 was designated as Polling Day for all other registered electors and polling was conducted between 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m., at the designated stations in each constituency.
- 10.3.2 Two hundred and fifty five thousand, eight hundred and eighty one (255, 881) persons were registered to vote on Polling Day.
- 10.3.3 The number of registered electors totalled two hundred and fifty eight thousand, nine hundred and one (258, 901) as follows:

Electors registered to vote on Thursday May 24, 2018: 255,881

### 11. COUNTING OF VOTES AND PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

11.1 Transport Board buses with Police escorts were used to transport Presiding Officers with ballot boxes, other Election Officers and Polling Agents to the Counting Centres.

In the court case, CV 709 of 2018 (Forty four Claimants) Beverley Akcayli et.al. and the Chief Electoral Officer, First Respondent, the Electoral and Boundaries Commission, Second Respondent, which was heard on Polling Day, approximately two hours before the close of the poll, the Chief Justice ordered that the names of fourteen commonwealth citizens be entered on the Register for Elections by means of an addendum. Carrying out this order resulted in the late closure of some polling stations. The vehicles retained for transporting the Special Polling Day ballot boxes were used to deliver the addenda to the polling stations and this resulted in the late delivery of the

Special Polling Day ballot boxes to the Counting Centres and very late commencement of the counting of votes.

11.2 During the Count, the Returning Officer in each constituency made periodic reports to the media on the progress of the Count. The result of the Count of each box was also entered into a computer programme, 'the Election Management System' (EMS), which was monitored from a command centre in the Office and from which the media was provided the results via a live feed.

### 12. ELECTION EXPENSES

- 12.1 In accordance with Section 52 (1) of the Act, all Candidates/Election Agents were required to file a Statement of Election Expenses with the Supervisor of Elections within seven weeks of the declaration of the results of the election.
- 12.2 Candidates/Election Agents are allowed to incur expenses to a maximum of \$10.00 in respect of each person registered as a voter in their respective constituencies. Appendix "D" shows the amount expended on behalf of each candidate.
