Resolution to approve in accordance with Section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225, the lease to the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Barbados Charity of the parcel of land, the property of the Crown, namely Lot 2, being part of the property known as Culloden Farm in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island to be used as a headquarters-base to house the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Barbados Charity and to facilitate its development programme.
