INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Board of Management St. Leonard's Boys' Secondary School

1. Principal activity

St. Leonard's Boys Secondary School is an educational, non-profit oriented public sector institution, owned by the Government of Barbados and managed by the Ministry of Education and Human Resources Development.

Principal accounting policies 2.

Basis of preparation

The statements of receipts and disbursements and fund balance have been prepared on a cash basis. On this basis, revenue is recorded when received rather than when earned, and expenses are recorded when paid rather than when incurred.

Plant, equipment and furniture

The cost of plant, equipment and furniture is included in the statement of receipts and disbursements in the year in which the cash is disbursed.

Capital grants

Legislative grants include grants for the acquisition of plant, equipment and furniture. Such grants are included in the statement of receipts and disbursements and fund

3. Value added tax

The school recorded expenses of \$61,318 (2011 - \$108,435) pertaining to Value Added Tax for the year. This amount has been included in the related expense categories in the statement of receipts and payments. The school is however eligible to receive a refund of these taxes under section 56 of the Value Tax Act, 1996 - 15, Cap. 87.
