## Resolution Regarding the Commemoration of the Day of National Significance – July 26th

WHEREAS recalling that July 26th was declared as a Day of National Significance in recognition of the 1937 Disturbances.

AND WHEREAS recognising that these disturbances have served as a watershed in the socio-economic development of Barbados;

AND WHEREAS acknowledging the sacrifice made by those who gave their lives during these Disturbances to ensure that social, cultural and economic rights were enjoyed by all;

#### BE IT RESOLVED that the Parliament of Barbados:

- 1. Reminds Barbadians of the victory over injustice that was wrought through the 1937 Disturbances;
- 2. Embraces the lessons learned from the struggle of the 1937 Disturbances;
- 3. Encourages Barbadians to fully appreciate the importance and meaning of July 26th the Day of National Significance and all its symbolises;

- 4. Re-affirms its commitment to the high ideals of good goverance and social justice for all as a lasting legacy from the 1937 Disturbances.
