- 3. Resolution to approve in accordance with section 28(c) of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228 the sale of a parcel of land, the property of the State, situate at Lot 13, Lower Estate in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island to Edgstrong Holdings Ltd., a company incorporated under the Companies Act, Cap. 308.

VALUE ADDED TAX (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2023
