CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 241 of the *Customs Act*, makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.
- 2. Regulation 83 of the Customs Regulations (L.N. 1963 No. 61), in these regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, is amended by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following:
 - "(2) A declaration referred to in paragraph (1) shall be in the form set out as Form C. 23 in the *Schedule* and shall be submitted to the Customs Department
 - (a) online via the website of the Customs Department; or
 - (b) by using an automated passport control kiosk.".
- 3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by
 - (a) deleting Form C. 23 and substituting the Form set out the Schedule; and
 - (b) deleting Form C. 24.
