The Honourable the House of Assembly has the honour to inform the Honourable the Senate that at its Sitting on Friday 21st December, 2018:-

- 1. The Honourable the House of Assembly **agreed** to and concurred in the amendments made by the Honourable the Senate on the 19th December, 2018 to the **Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill, 2018**.
- 2. The Honourable the House of Assembly disagreed with the Honourable the Senate in the amendments to the Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2018 made by the Honourable the Senate on the 19th December, 2018 for the subjoined reasons, and amended the Bill as follows:

#### In Clause 2 of the Bill:

(a) Delete the definition of "Community" or "CARICOM" and substitute the following:

"CARICOM means the Caribbean Community established by the Treaty."

and insert in the appropriate alphabetical order.

(b) Insert in the appropriate alphabetical order the following definition:

"Treaty" means the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas Establishing the Caribbean Community, including the CARICOM Single Market and Economy, that was signed in the Bahamas on 5th July, 2001.

The amendments made to the Bill by the Honourable the House on the 14th December, 2018 were made in error thereby rendering the amendments made by the Honourable the Senate on the 19th December, 2018, unnecessary.

**AND** the Honourable the House of Assembly transmits the amended Bill to the Honourable the Senate inviting concurrence in the amendments to the Bill.
