# INTRODUCTION

## **An Overview of the Registration Department**

The Registration Department is segmented in its functions and has the following sections:

1. **The Supreme Court** which comprises:
  1. The Court of Appeal
  2. The High Court

The Court of Appeal is presided over by Justices of Appeal and mainly deals with Appeals from the High Courts and Magistrates' Courts. The Chief Justice is President of the Court of Appeal.

The High Courts are presided over by the Judges of the High Court and deal with Civil and Family matters as well as Criminal offences that are committed for trial by the Magistrates' Courts.

2. **The Magistrate's Courts**

The Magistrates' Courts are courts of summary jurisdiction where a Magistrate acting without a jury conducts cases without delay or formality. Magistrates' Courts are located at the various districts throughout the island.

3. **The Court Process Office**

The Court Process Office has a statutory mandate that is set out in Section 5 of the Court Process Office Act and includes:

1. Execution of writs, warrants, orders for debt and the commands of any Judge or Magistrate;
2. Service of summonses and other documents or process required to be served by the Rules of the Court;
3. Attendance at Court when required
4. Performance of any other functions as required by any Court.

The Chief Marshal is responsible for the administration of the Court Process office. Administrative responsibility is exercised through the Court Process service.

#### **4. The Records Branch**

The Records Branch also referred to as the island's registry is responsible for the registration of vital statistics records, i.e. births, deaths, marriages and professional registrations.

The Registrar of the Supreme Court is responsible for the administration of the Registration Department.

#### **Functions of the Department**

The functions of the Registration Department are set out in various pieces of legislation.

These are:

- The Supreme Court Act (Cap 117A)
- The Supreme Court Rules
- The Magistrates' Courts Act (Cap 116A)
- The Court Process Office Act (Cap 111A)
- The Registration Office Act (Cap 33)

Several other pieces of legislation impact on the work of the Registration Department.

The functions include but are not limited to:

- Receiving all court documents
- Preparing case files for trial in the following court systems:
  - Appeals, Criminal, Civil and Family
- Processing application for grants of Probate and Letters of Administration
- Registering of Births, Stillbirths, Deaths and Marriages
- Registering of Professional persons
- Recording Deeds such as Powers of Attorneys, Deed Polls and deeds not pertaining to land

- Supplying authentic copies of documents and public records on the request and payment of the appropriate fees
- Researching and preparing certificates of births, deaths and marriages
- Processing of Liquor Licences
- Collecting fees and fines imposed by the Magistrates
- Collecting and disbursing maintenance money
- Performing Notary functions
- Serving Court documents

The functions of the Magistrates' Courts and the Court Process Office are paper based and are carried out manually. A computerized system was implemented in the Records Branch to automate the processes of registering births, deaths and marriages as well as the processes for searching and retrieving of information in respect of births, deaths and marriage certificates. While in the Supreme Court registries a Case Management System was implemented as a tool to manage the pace of litigation from initial filing to disposal.

## VOLUME OF LITIGATION

### SUPREME COURT

#### The Court of Appeal

During 2014, **37** Civil Appeals (High Court) were filed as compared with **19** in 2013 and **37** in 2012. **13** Civil Appeals (Magisterial) were filed as compared with **7** in 2013 and **3** in 2012.

**16** Criminal Appeals (High Court) were filed compared with **20** in 2013 and **26** in 2012; and **10** Magisterial Criminal Appeals as compared to **12** in 2013 and **18** in 2012.

In addition the Court of Appeal heard **54** Appeals, **34** decisions were given and **62** Chamber Applications were disposed of.

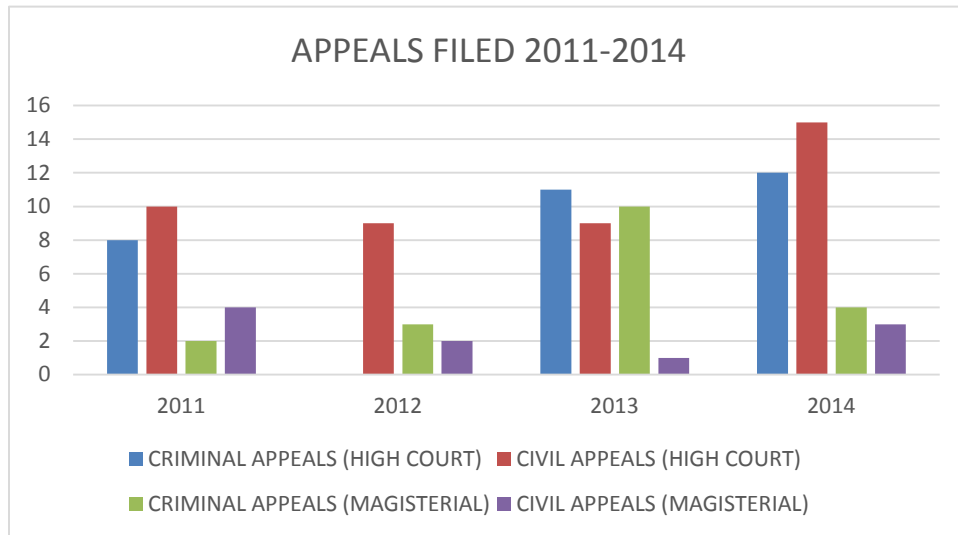

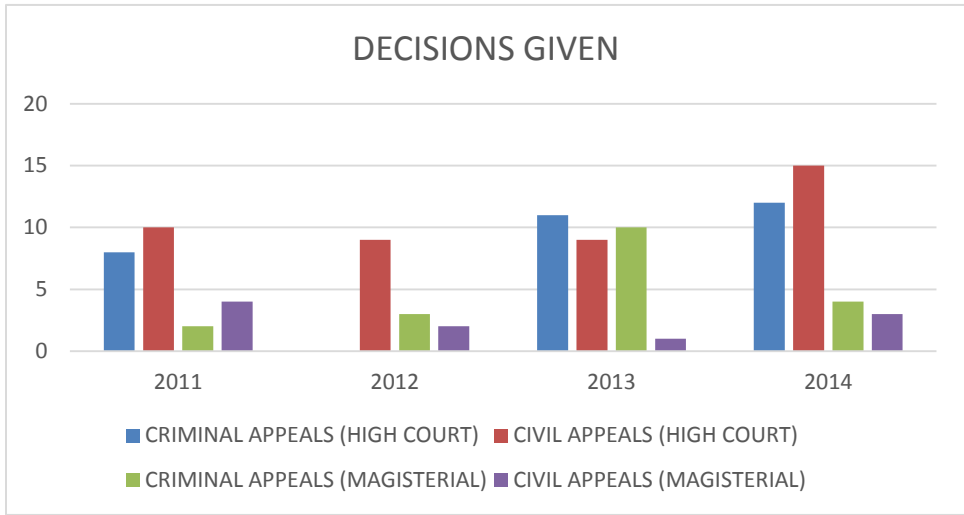
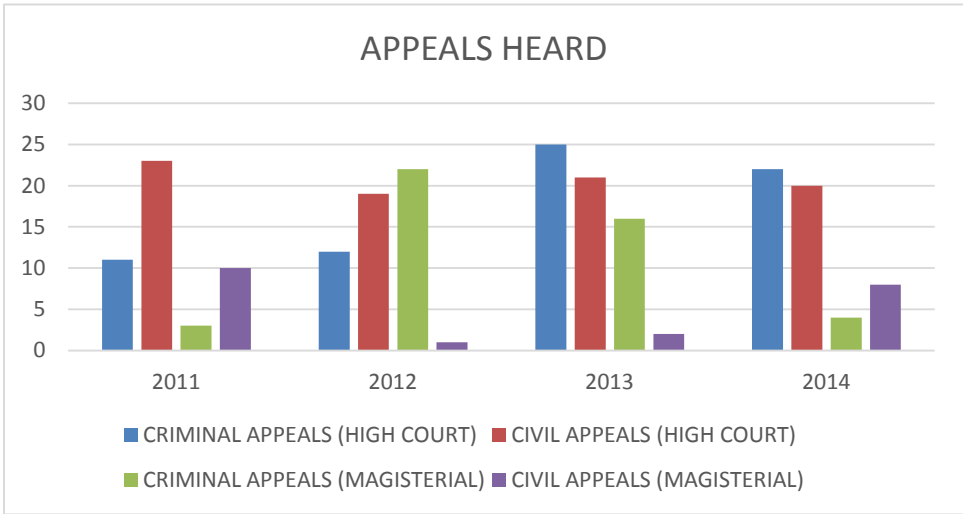

**The High Court**

In the High Court **1898** Civil cases were filed compared with **2225** in 2013 and **2273** in 2012. **971** Probate applications were filed as compared with **915** in 2013 and **1193** in 2012.

On the Criminal side there were **245** indictments as compared to **187** in 2013 and **178** in 2012.



**443** Divorce applications were filed as compared with **459** in 2013 and **472** in 2012. The Divorce rate was **23.88** per 100 marriages. See Tables 8 and 20.

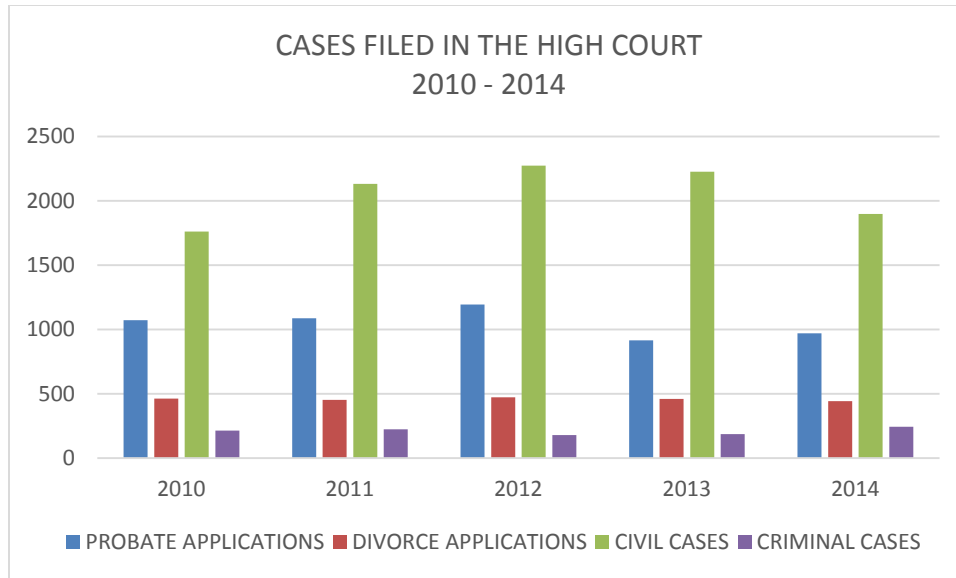
The number of children affected by Divorces according to Section 3 of the Family Law Act, Cap. 214 were **259** in 2014. The corresponding number for 2013 was **316** as compared with **295** in 2012.

***Other Family Applications***

**13** applications involving **Unions** were filed as compared with **12** in 2013 and **27** in 2012; **22 Custody** applications as compared with **12** in 2013 and **12** in 2012; **1 Annulment** as compared with **2** in 2013 and **0** in 2012; There was 1 application for **Paternity** in 2012 as compared with **1** in 2013 and **0** in 2012; **54** applications for **Maintenance** were filed as compared with **61** in 2013 and **54** in 2012; **3** applications for **Property** settlement were filed as compared with **3** in 2013 and **8** in 2012; **3** applications for **Adoptions** as compared with **4** in 2013 and **3** in 2012; and 8 miscellaneous applications as compared with **10** in 2013 and **11** in 2012.

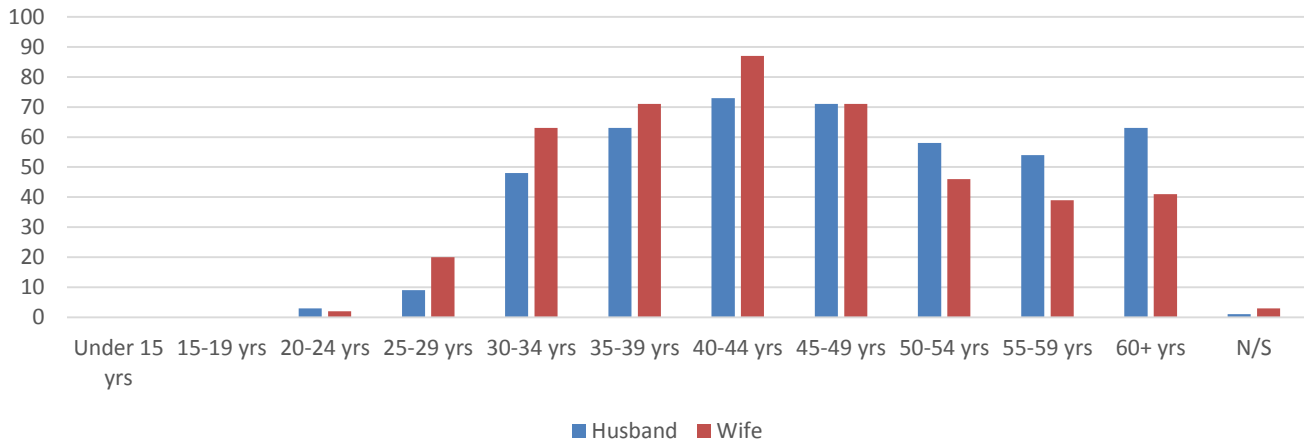

## **THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS**

The Magistrates' Courts of summary jurisdiction where a Magistrate acting without a jury can conduct cases without much delay or formality. The Magistrates' Courts are located at various districts throughout the Island.

During the year 2014, 4429 Criminal cases, **18327** Traffic cases, **2178** Civil cases, **1710** Domestic cases, **283** Domestic Violence cases and **79** Juvenile cases were lodged.

### ***District 'A'***

The two (2) Criminal Courts disposed of **2098** cases as compared with **2103** in 2013. The Traffic Court disposed of **5123** cases as compared with **4806** in 2013. In the Civil court **779** cases were disposed of as compared with **913** in 2013 and in the Domestic court **1043** cases were disposed of as compared with **1485** in 2013. A total of **65** Juvenile cases were adjudicated during the year.

### ***District 'B' (Boarded Hall)***

For the period January to October this court adjudicated **1251** cases. A total of **1706** cases were disposed of during the year 2013.

***District 'B' (Oistins)*** This court adjudicated a total of **1000** cases as compared with **1148** in 2013.

***District 'C'*** adjudicated **350** cases as at January 2014. No other figures are available to date.

***District 'D'*** adjudicated **303** cases as compared with **348** in 2013.

***District 'E'*** adjudicated **1024** cases as compared with **745** in 2013.

***District 'E' (Holetown)*** adjudicated a total of **2556**

***District 'F'*** adjudicated **217** cases as compared with **217** in 2013.

***District 'F' (Belleplaine)*** adjudicated **270** cases as compared with **231** in 2013.

**283** Protection Orders were filed under the Domestic Violence Act, Cap. 130 of the laws of Barbados. 5502 cases were previously filed making a total of **5785** cases filed from the commencement of the Act to the end of 2015.

## CIVIL REGISTRATIONS

### RECORD BRANCH

#### Population

At the end of the year, the population of Barbados was estimated at approximately **276 937**. During the year births exceeded deaths by **306**.

The growth of population covering a period of 5 years is shown as appended in Table 18.

The mid-year population from which several rates of births, deaths and marriages are calculated was **277 199**. (See tables 20 and 21)

The size of Barbados is 166.55 square miles or acreage of 106, 592.

The Island is divided into eleven parishes with the principal City of Bridgetown located in the parish of St. Michael.

The density per square mile for the Island was **1662.79** as compared with **1661.81** in 2013.

#### ***Births***

Live births registered during the year were **2907** with males totaling **1487** and females **1420**. (See Table 24)

The birth rate was **10.49** per one thousand of the mid-year population. (See Table 20)

Live Birth Order: Age of mother and order of birth is shown in Table 23.

There were **29** cases of twins registered during 2014 as compared with **31** in 2013 and **34** in 2012. There were **no** recorded cases of triplets during the year.

The number of stillbirth registrations in 2014 was **24** with males totaling **10** and females **13**. There was one case in which the sex of the child was not stated. (See Tables 22 and 26)

The stillbirth rate was **8.26** per 1000 of live births. (See Table 20).

### ***Fertility***

The respective age groups of mother and order of birth of their children are set out in Table 23. There were **5** births to a mother under the age of 15 years as compared to **3** in 2013 and **1** in 2012.

Female births for the year 2014 numbered **1420** as compared with **1484** in 2013 and **1542** in 2012.

### ***Adoption***

**3** children were adopted under the provisions on the Adoption Act Chapter 212 of the Laws of Barbados. **394** were previously adopted making a total of **397** from the commencement of the Act to the end of the year.

### ***Deaths***

**2601** deaths were registered in 2014. Males were **1319**, females **1282**. The death rate was 9.38 per 1000 of the mid-year population. (See Tables 25 and 20)

There were **30** deaths under the age of one year, males **20** and females **10**. The infant death rate was **10.32**. (See tables 22, 28 and 20).

The maternal mortality rate for 2014 is not available.

There were **804** deaths of persons of the age 85 and over as compared to **739** in 2013. (See Table 28) There were **48** deaths of persons over the age of 100.

The cause of death as classified under 17 heads or groups for the years 2011- 2014 is not yet available.

The International lists of causes are included in the report of the Director of Medical Services for the year.

## ***Marriages***

There were **1855** marriages registered during 2014. Of the contracting parties **1321** were bachelors, **1413** spinsters, **52** widowers, **32** widows, **481** divorced men and **409** divorced women. There was **1** marriage registered with the status of the male and female not being stated. (See table 31).

The relative ages of the bride and bridegrooms are shown in Table 30. Marriages by the month of occurrences are shown in Table 29. The marriage rate was **6.69** as shown in Table 20.

Marriages increased by **1.40 %** as compared with 2013. The register showed no male and no female signed his/her name by his/ her mark.

Civil marriages, which were performed by the several Magistrates, were **256**.

## **Professional Registrations**

A person who engages or intends to engage in a profession, trade, business or calling, is required to register in respect of each profession, trade, business or calling in accordance with the Profession, Trade and Business Registration Act Cap. 373 of the Laws of Barbados.

The number of professionals registered in each category are set out in the table below:

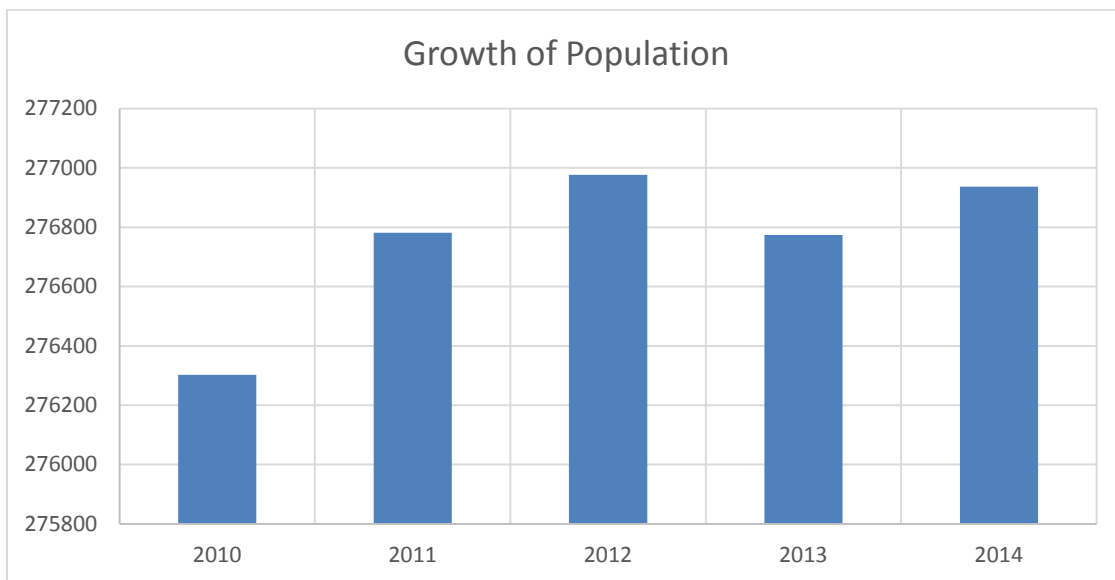
