30th June, 2017

Dear Madam President,

I have the honour to inform the Honourable The Senate that with the approval of Her Majesty The Queen, I shall demit the office of Governor-General, on retirement, on 30th June, 2017.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 29 (1)(a) of the Constitution, Sir Philip Marlowe Greaves, K.A., Q.C., will perform the functions of the Office as Acting Governor-General.

As the Honourable The Senate will not be meeting prior to my demitting office, it will not be possible for the usual formal Message to be sent down to your Chamber. Will you, therefore, please bring my retirement to the attention of The Honourable The Senate when next it meets.
