**THE HONOURABLE THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY**

The Honourable the Senate has the honour to inform the Honourable the House of Assembly that at its sitting on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2018** the **Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2018** and the **Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill, 2018** were amended in the terms as cited below.

In the **Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2018** at Clause 2 the definition of "*CARICOM*" was deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"Community" or "*CARICOM*" means the Caribbean Community established by Article 2 of the Treaty and includes the CARICOM Single Market and Economy signed at Nassau, the Bahamas on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2001.;

and placed after the definition "code share information".

And the definition of "*Treaty*" was deleted.

In the **Stamp Duty (Amendment) Bill, 2018** at Clause 2 the paragraph (i) was deleted

**AND** the Honourable the Senate transmits the Amended Bills to the Honourable the House of Assembly inviting concurrence in the amendments to the Bills.
