ALL THAT land the property of Tiny Tots Limited situate at Bay Street in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 7 328.3 square metres (inclusive of 158.4 square metres in road and 3831.3 square metres in beach) Abutting and Bounding on lands now or formerly of Vision Developments Inc. on the sea on lands now or formerly of M. G. Tucker and Co. Ltd., and on a public road known as Bay Street leading to Chamberlain Bridge in one direction and to Wellington Street in the other direction or however else the same may abut and bound together with the buildings thereon, as shown and delineated on a Plan certified on the 10th day of May, 2019 by Anderson R.
