AND WHEREAS in accordance with Standing Order 28(21) of the Standing Orders of the House of Assembly a Member moving a motion or speaking in reply is required to be physically present in the Chamber;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the duration of the examination of the Estimates by the Standing Finance Committee for the Member moving the particular Head and speaking in reply to make his presentation virtually;

BE IT RESOLVED that this House empowers the Chairman of Committees to designate the Committee Room of Parliament as the place where examination by the Standing Finance Committee of the Head of the relevant Ministry is to be conducted;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the purpose of the examination of the Estimates that the Member moving the particular Head and speaking in reply be allowed to make that presentation virtually from the said Committee Room,

and moved seconded by Hon. J. A. King that the Resolution be passed.
