By a recent survey, the said land is now found to contain by admeasurement 4007.9 square metres as shown on a Plan certified on the 18th day of February, 2020 by Kevin R. Belgrave, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 5th day of March, 2020 as Plan No. 305/2020.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the parcel of land together with the building thereon described in the *Schedule* to this Resolution in order that the public purpose set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land together with the building thereon.


