NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY (BENEFITS) ORDER, 2019

The National Insurance Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 25A of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security* (Benefits) Order, 2019.
- 2. With effect from 7th January, 2019, the amount to be paid weekly as
 - (a) old age contributory pension; and
 - (b) invalidity pension

shall not be less than \$239 per week.

- 3. With effect from 7th January, 2019, the amount to be paid weekly as survivor's pension shall be calculated on a sum not less than \$239 per week.
- 4. With effect from the 7th January, 2019, an insured person who on or before 31st December, 2018 had been entitled to
 - (a) an old age contributory pension;
 - (b) a survivor's pension;
 - (c) a death benefit; or
 - (d) an invalidity pension

shall be paid an additional amount of 1.58 per cent of the pension benefit to which that person had been entitled on 31st December, 2018.

- 5. With effect from 1st January, 2019,
 - (a) a funeral grant shall be an amount of \$2 150;
 - (b) a maternity grant shall be an amount of \$1 240.
- 6. The National Insurance and Social Security (Benefits) Order, 2017 (S.I. 2017 No. 22) is revoked.
