### ADDENDUM

The Cabinet at its meeting held on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2016 agreed to the acquisition of a parcel of land from Marriott Barbados Limited totalling approximately 10.5 hectares at Harrismith in the parish of Saint Philip for housing and tourism development.

In accordance with the provisions of section 3 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228, a Notice pertaining to the parcel of land described in the *Schedule* herein was published by Statutory Instrument on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016, the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of September, 2016 and the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2016.

The Resolution to acquire the parcel of land described in the *Schedule* herein was approved by the House of Assembly on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020, approved by the Senate on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2020, assented to by the Governor-General on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2020 and published in the *Official Gazette* as Resolution No. 4/2020 on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2020.

The Cabinet at its meeting held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2020 agreed to the abandonment of the said acquisition on the land described in the *Schedule* herein at Harrismith, in the parish of Saint Philip.

# ADDENDUM - (Concl'd)

In accordance with the provisions of section 9 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228 the approval of Parliament is now sought for the publication of the Notice of Abandonment as required by section 9(1) of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228 for the parcel of land mentioned in the *Schedule* herein.
