### ORDER NO. 3

# BRITISH AMERICAN INSURANCE COMPANY (BARBADOS) LTD. (PRESERVATION OF INVESTMENTS) (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2020

On the Order being called for Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney to move the second reading of the Bill entitled an Act to amend the British American Insurance Company (Barbados) Ltd. (Preservation of Investments) Act, 2016 (2016-5),

the Hon. Member sought and obtained leave to introduce the Bill together with Order No. 4 in a cognate debate.

Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney spoke and moved that the Bill be read a second time.

The Bill was read a second time.

On the motion of Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney the Honourable the Senate resolved itself into Committee on the Bill, His Honour the Deputy President in the Chair.

Clauses 1 to 3 were called and passed on the separate motion of Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney.

On the motion of Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney the Chairman of Committees reported the passing of the Bill in Committee to the President who resumed the Chair and reported accordingly.

On the separate motion of Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney the Bill was read a third time and passed and the title read and agreed to.

### **ORDER NO. 4**

On the motion of Senator the Hon. Miss K. S. McConney the following Resolution was passed:

WHEREAS by section 3 of the *British American Insurance Company* (Barbados) Ltd. (Preservation of Investments) Act, 2016 (Act 2016-5), the Government of Barbados is authorised with the approval of both Houses of Parliament, to provide financial assistance to Sagicor Life Inc. in order to facilitate the preservation of the pension plans for 68 employees of the British American Insurance Company (Barbados) Ltd.;

AND WHEREAS by section 6(1) of the said Act it is provided that the Government of Barbados shall, by a resolution of both Houses of Parliament, issue 6 bonds of varying maturities from 5 to 30 years, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of \$8.115 million to Sagicor Life Inc.;

AND WHEREAS the Government considers it necessary to issue the said 6 bonds in the amount of \$8.115 million in order to assist Sagicor Life Inc. with the preservation of the pension plans of 68 employees of the British American Insurance Company (Barbados) Ltd.;

AND WHEREAS the said sum of \$8.115 million is within the authorised limit given to the Government under section 6(1) of the said Act;

BE IT RESOLVED therefore that Parliament approves the issuing of 6 bonds to Sagicor Life Inc. for an amount of \$8.115 million on the terms and conditions set out in the *Schedule* to this Resolution.

APPROVED by the House of Assembly the 6th day of March, 2020.
